Summary of Objective¹

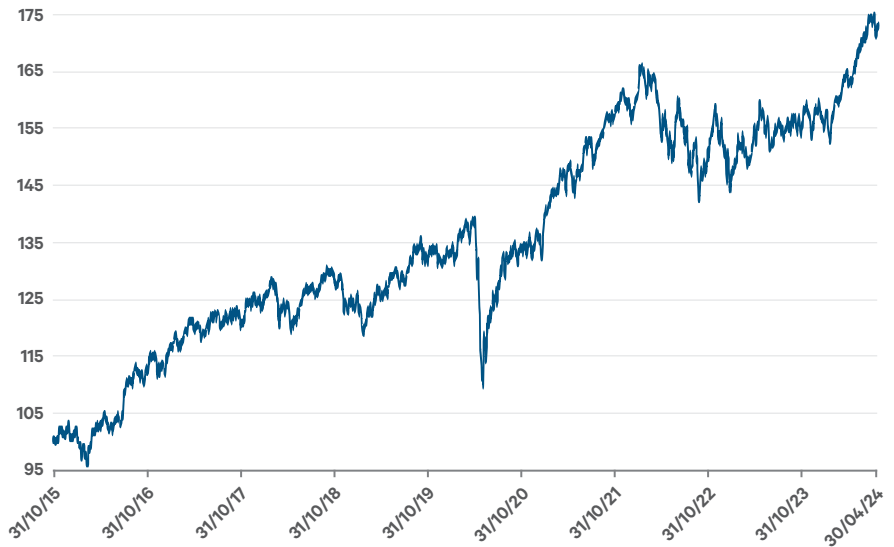
The objective of the Davy UK GPS Long Term Growth Fund is to achieve long-term capital growth by investing primarily in a portfolio of higher risk assets.

Figure 2: Asset Allocation

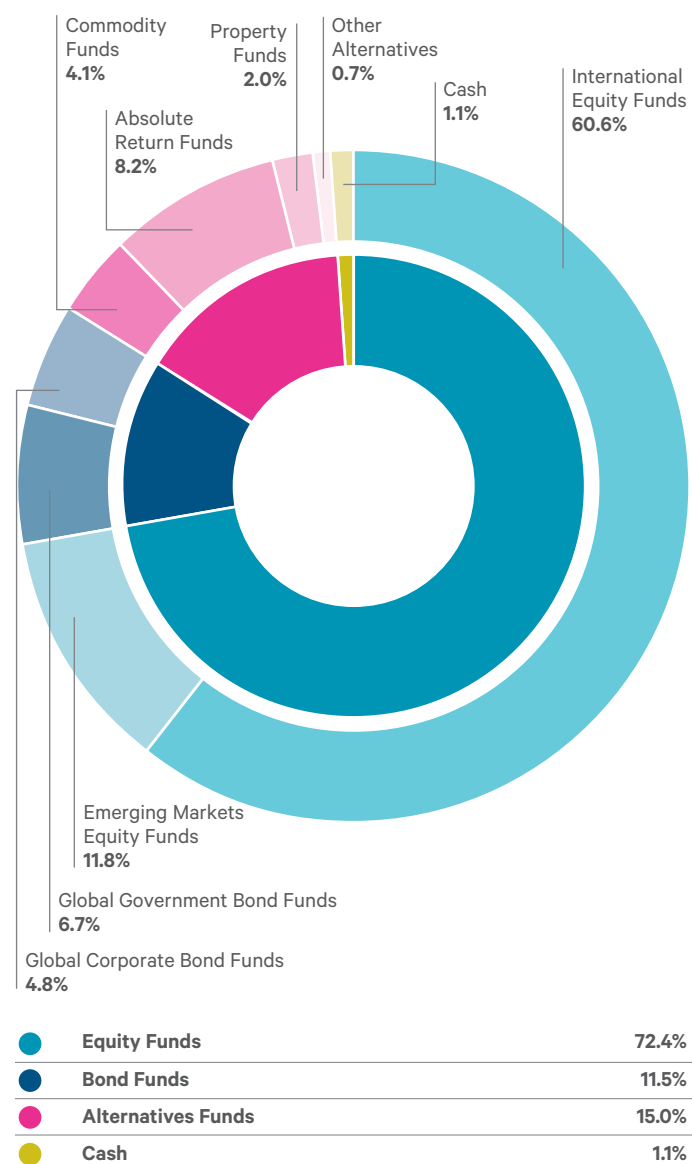
